I am a saber-toothed tiger.

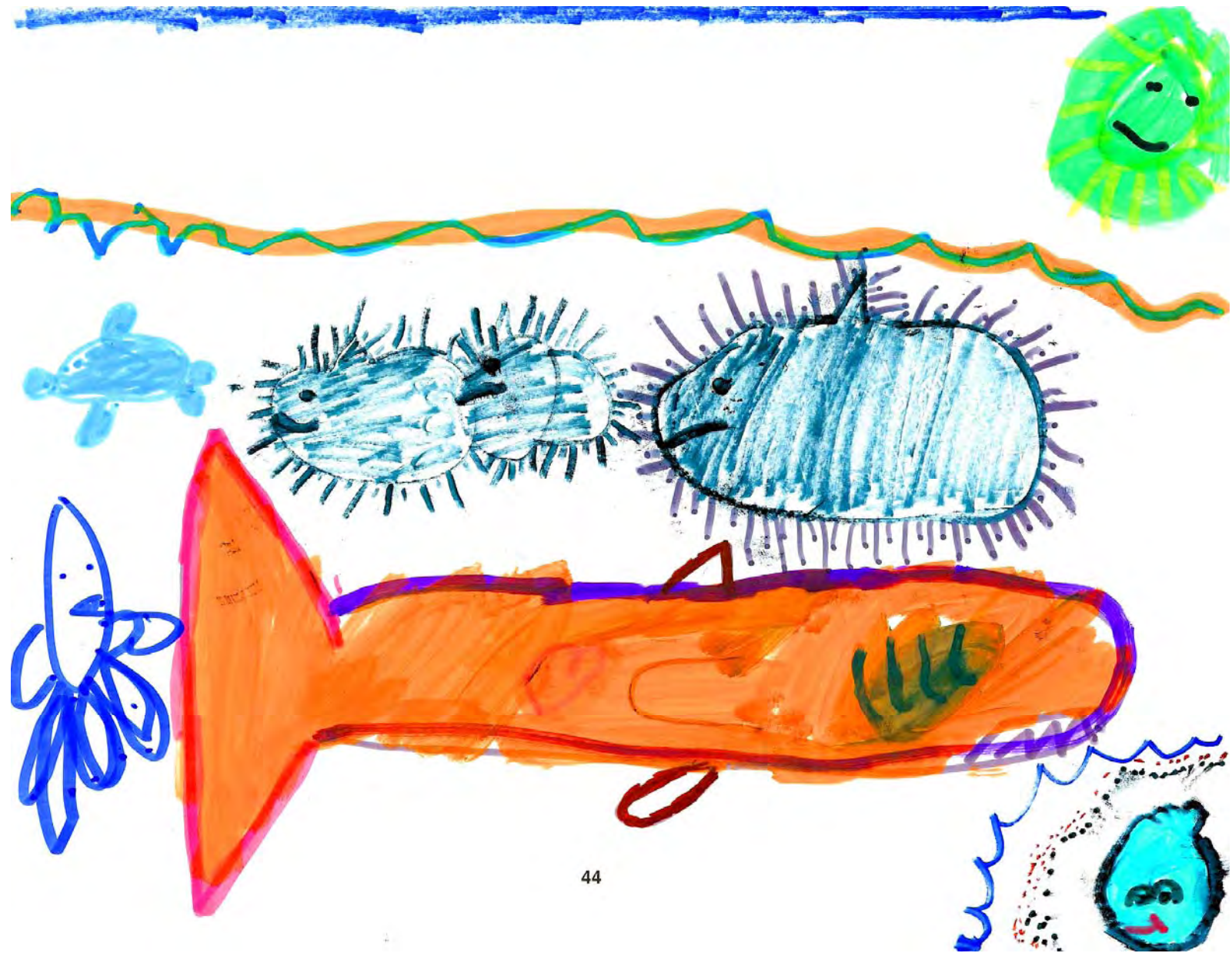

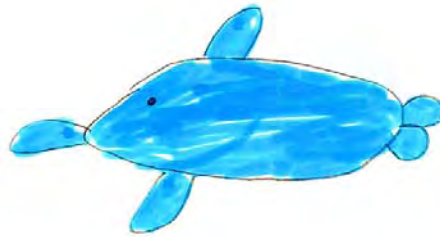


We're the ones who fly so high, high, high -
