I am a colorful rose!



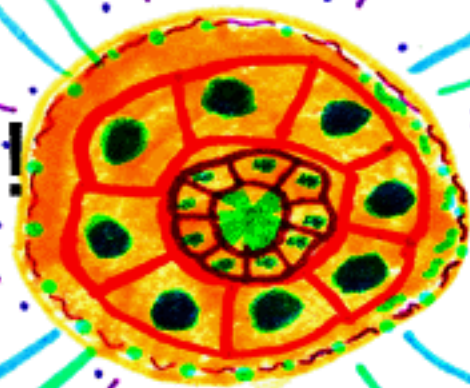
I am blazing hot.

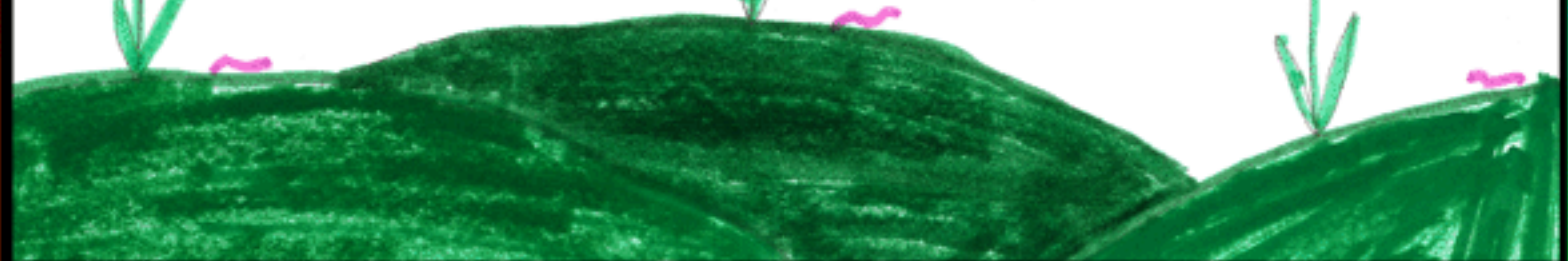


I would live in California.

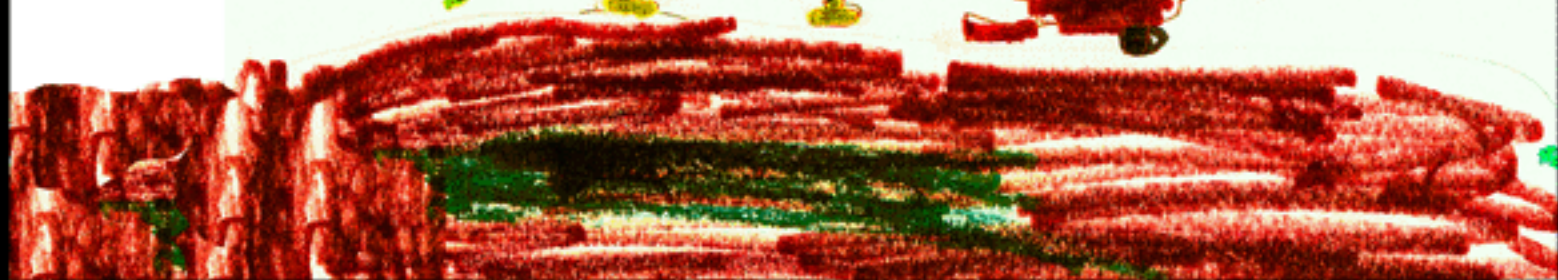
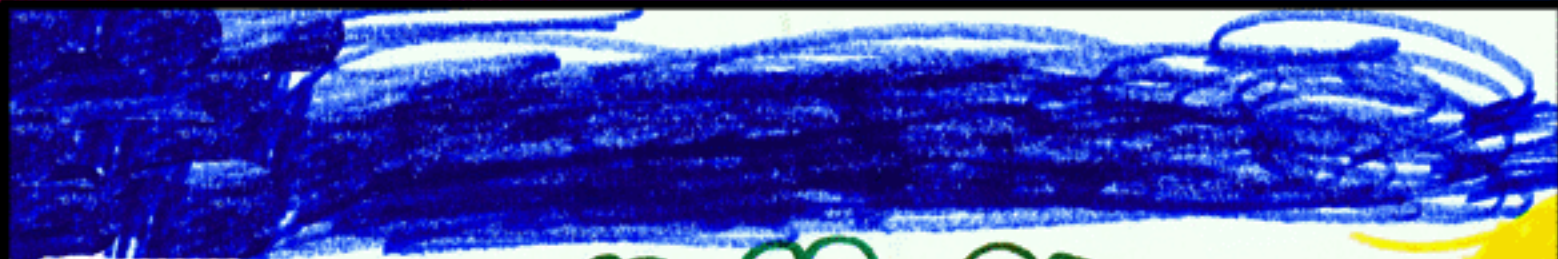
I would live in a tree in Africa.

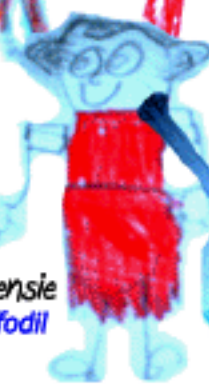

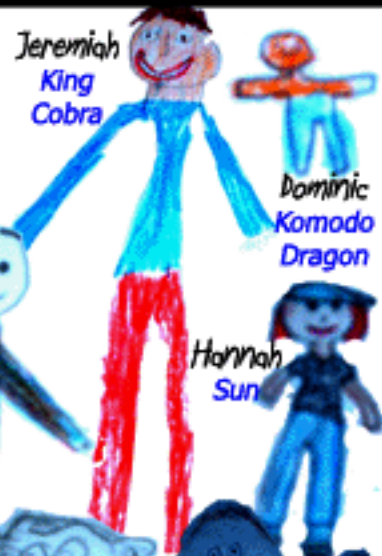
